**Submission Guidelines**

*J19* is the official publication of C19: The Society of Nineteenth-Century Americanists. Published twice annually, the journal is dedicated to publishing innovative research on and analysis of the "long nineteenth century" (1783-1914).

*J19* follows the guidelines of the *Chicago Manual of Style*, 16th edition.

The editors invite essay submissions in all areas of American cultural studies from the late eighteenth to the early twentieth centuries. Below find the formatting guidelines for submissions:

- Manuscripts should not be under consideration elsewhere
- No more than thirty-five double-spaced pages, including notes
- No identifying information about the author in the submission, except in an accompanying file that includes title of submission, author's name, email and regular mail address
- Word documents, no pdfs.
- Must include 100-200 word abstract and be submitted as a Word document

All submissions will be peer-reviewed in a timely manner. We encourage submissions from all disciplines.
